FAQ's

How will leagues be set up?

Age divisions are determined by the age of the player on June 1, 2019. The Golf League has divisions for ages 5-14. 5-9 age division will play a Scramble and 10-14 age division will play Best Ball. Each team will have 4-5 players and will be divided by YMCA staff at random.

Scramble: Each team member plays a shot. The team determines the best shot and they all play from that position. Repeat this process until the ball is holed.

Best Ball: Each team members plays the hole. IF player one records a 5 and player two records a 4, the team uses the score of 4 for that hole.

Are the teams co-ed?

All age groups are co-ed for Golf League.

What equipment is used?

Every player will receive a shirt for the matches. Tennis shoes or golf shoes are appropriate footwear while on the golf course for match. Golf clubs will be provided for the 5-9 age division; however if participant has their own set they may use their own during matches. Participants in the 10-14 age division will need to have their own set of clubs; however, some clubs may be available upon request.

Cancellations/Rain Outs

Match Lengths and Location

5-9yr. olds – total of 5 holes played each match, played at K of C
10-14 yr. olds – total of 9 holes played each match, played at Cedar Crest.

What if my child and I know nothing about golf?

This league is for beginners! Participants will learn the basic fundamentals and rules of golf during the free clinic and have the 6 week league matches to continue to practice their skill. We will



also have a collegiate golfer on site as a rules official and to assist in technique as needed.
